First Aid

A First Aid station is located at each event area; the main event hub; kids zone; marine display. These stations will have a first aid kit available. The main event hub will also have a registered nurse available. If you require any assistance during the day, please head to one of these stations.

Toilets

Toilets are located at both the main event hub and in the kids zone.

Dogs

Dogs are not permitted at the event; unless for medical reasons.

Bikes/Scooters/Prams

Prams are permitted.

However due to safety concerns, please do not bring bikes/scooters or other similar items into the event.

Lost Kids

Our Lost Child Area is located at the front entrance of the event (Patterson Logistics Centre). In the event of a lost child, public announcements will be made via megaphone announcements.

Footwear

Sensible, sturdy footwear (no high heels or jandals) is required for climbing onto allocated plant and equipment.

Smoking/Alcohol

Smoking and alcohol is not permitted at this event.

Photography

Photographers will be taking photos throughout the event which may be used across public media channels.
